### How to Play

1. Pick a path for visiting the flags for each game round.

For example, for one round, you can visit all the flags on the left from front to back and then visit the left side from back to front until someone calls BINGO.

Another option is to go back and forth across the avenue from the front to back.

Another option would be to visit them in alphabetical order.

- 2. Mark each flag on your BINGO card once ALL of the group has reached the flag. No skipping ahead.
- 3. All the flags between the first flag on the selected path and the flag where a player called BINGO must be marked in order for the BINGO card to be a valid winning card. Skipping flags or marking flags without or ahead of visiting the flag with the group is not allowed.
- 4. The winner of the game is the first to achieve BINGO AND the first to call out "BINGO".

BINGO is achieved by marking five in a row on your BINGO card. If two players call out BINGO at about the same time, the group will determine by vote who was the first to call out.

If the call is still disputed, the oldest person in the group who is not claiming BINGO will determine which player they heard first.

If the first BINGO call cannot be determined by vote or by elder, then the game is tie, providing both cards are verified as a BINGO.

The game moderator (or supervising adult) will verify the winning card(s).

- 5. Respect other visitors at the park.
- 6. Have Fun!
